● EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

If you fall into one of the categories below you might qualify!

In 2023, is your income less than...

Number of children*	Single, head of household, or widowed	Married filing jointly
Zero	\$17,640	\$24,210
One	\$46,560	\$53,120
Two	\$52,918	\$59,478
Three	\$56,838	\$63,698

*This includes children under 19; children under 24 who are full-time students; or of any age and permanently and totally disabled.

What is a refundable tax credit?

It's a credit on your taxes that reduces the amount you owe, with the balance paid to you in cash. If you owe zero in taxes, you receive the full credit in cash.
