

Crafting the State Budget

| July 1 | Beginning of State Fiscal Year (referred to by calendar year of second half of fiscal year – so July 2017 = FY18) |
|---|---|
| July-August | Department-level budget requests are developed for the next Fiscal Year |
| September-October | Agencies review Department budget requests, and develop Agency-wide budget requests to send to the Governor |
| November-December | Governor's office drafts Governor's Recommended Budget |
| December (in odd years)/ January (in even years) | House Appropriations Committee begins work on Budget Adjustment Act (BAA) for current Fiscal Year |
| Mid-January | Governor releases Recommended Budget for next Fiscal Year |
| Late January – Mid February | BAA finalized and passed |

Crafting the State Budget

| January-February | House Appropriations Committee reviews Governor's Recommend, works on House version of budget |
|------------------|---|
| February-March | Senate Appropriations Committee reviews Governor's Recommended Budget |
| Late March | House passes their version of the budget |
| April | Senate Appropriations Committee reviews House Budget, Senate passes their version of the budget |
| May | House/Senate Conference Committee reviews differences and develops compromise budget, which is passed by both chambers and then sent to the Governor for approval or veto |
| June 30 | End of State Fiscal Year |
| NOT | E: The Vermont Constitution outlines the state's budget-making process, and requires that any budget bills be passed first in the House, and then be considered by the Senate. |

Budget Process for '24

- Normal FY24 Budget Adjustment Process [Jan.-Feb.]
- Normal FY25 Budget Process [Feb.-May]
- Policy Committees in House submitted letters as usual Senate letters uncertain
- Joint Fiscal Cmte. decision-making process still potentially in play [post-session]

Alliance Leg Agenda Issues – FY25 Budget

Larger

- Temporary Shelter (GA) and Affordable Housing
- Fair Share for VT Revenue proposal
- Act 76 Implementation

Smaller

- PCC Network
- Vermont 211
- Empty Arms (Perinatal Peer Support)

Currently Inactive/Minimal Impact

- Reach Up
- Doula Medicaid Access
- Paid Leave
- VT Tax Credits

Governor's Recommended FY25 Budget

- Relatively few surprises, but some key spending items not included
- Few policy initiatives being proposed
- Two large cuts proposed to CCFAP spending (FY24 and FY25)
- No large cuts or increases in other EC areas
- Significant housing proposals

House FY25 Budget

- Rejects proposed large cut proposed to CCFAP spending (FY25 base)
- No large cuts or increases in other EC areas
- Significant housing proposals (and revenue generation) [H. 829/879]
- Includes Fair Share revenue proposal, Vermont 211 funding
- Does not include PCC Network, Empty Arms requests
- No increases for Reach Up

Complicating factors

- House Appropriations process was not as transparent as usual, especially for one-time proposals
- Several bills/initiatives travelled outside the usual budget process in the House (especially housing H. 829/879)
- House relying heavily on contingency ("waterfall") for emergency housing
- As a result, House Budget likely to be changed by the Senate more than usual
- Revenue revisions in April and/or July Joint Fiscal Cmte. will make July decisions
